Precautionary Measures

All staff who have travelled and returned from China are to self-quarantine at home and return to office only after 14 days from their date of return.



All staff are to monitor their health condition closely and report to their supervisors if they develop any symptoms of respiratory tract infection or have in social contacts with a suspected sufferer, whether or not they have travelled overseas.



There is only a single point of entry for visitors to our office. All visitors are to have their temperatures taken, to self-declare their health conditions, their last 14-day travel history and their personal particulars for contact tracing if necessary.

These measures will be adjusted depending on the prevailing situation.
