

# LIST OF ESSENTIAL GOODS

(Correct as at 2 April 2020)

For the purposes of the Regulations published in terms of GN 318 of 18 March 2020 (as amended), "essential goods" are defined as "*the goods referred to in paragraph A of Annexure B, as may be amended from time to time by the Cabinet member designated under section 3 of the Disaster Management Act*".

## Paragraph A of Annexure B of the Regulations published in terms of GN 318 of 18 March 2020 list the following as Essential Goods:

- Food
  - Any food product, including non-alcoholic beverages
  - Animal food
  - Chemicals, packaging and ancillary products used in the production of any food product
- Cleaning and Hygiene Products
  - Toilet Paper, sanitary pads, sanitary tampons, condoms
  - Hand sanitiser, disinfectants, soap, alcohol for industrial use, household
  - Cleaning products, and personal protective equipment
  - Chemicals, packaging and ancillary products used in the production of any of the above
  - Products for the care of babies and toddlers
  - Personal toiletries, including haircare, body and face washes, roll-ons, deodorants, toothpaste
- Medical:
  - Medical and Hospital Supplies, medicine, equipment and personal protective equipment
  - Chemicals, packaging and ancillary products used in the production of any of the above
- Fuel, including coal, wood and gas
- Basic goods, including airtime, electricity and the withdrawal of cash
