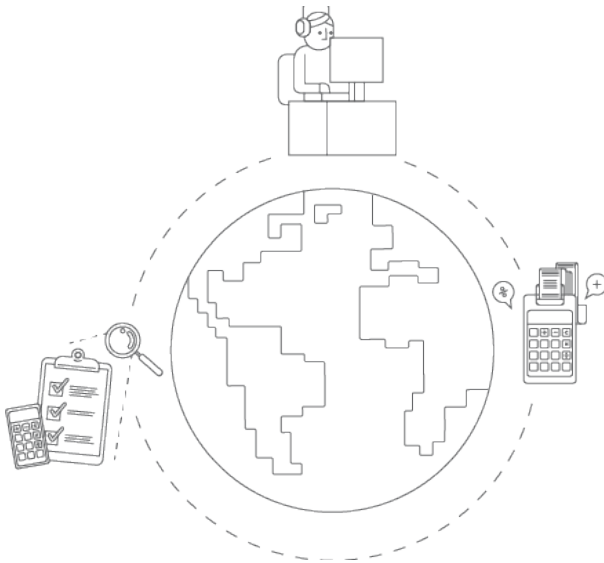

### Resolution no. 68/NQ-CP

On July 1, 2021 the Government issued Resolution No. 68/NQ-CP ("Resolution 68") on policies to support employees and employers facing difficulties due to the COVID-19 pandemic. **Q** What support policies have the Da Nang city authorities had for businesses, business households and business individuals during the outbreak?

**A** To support businesses, business households and business individuals to overcome the impacts of Covid-19, in addition to the policies issued from 2020, the extension of the deadline for payment of value-added tax, corporate income tax, and personal income tax and land rent in 2021 according to Decree No. 52/2021/ND-CP is considered a support policy with many beneficiaries businesses, business households and business individuals.

**Q** Reacting to unpredictable situations of the pandemic, what plans does the Danang city government have for economic development in 2022?

**A** Danang authorities develop **three growth scenarios** for 2022 at three levels: **low, medium, and high**. Specifically, the city has a GDP growth rate of **4.47%, 5.75%, and 7.01%** in 2022 compared to 2021 in the low, medium, and high scenarios respectively.

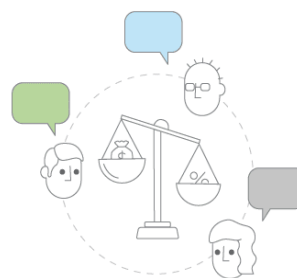
