

NEW POINTS ON REGIONAL MINIMUM WAGE

from 01 July 2022

From 01 July 2022, the regional minimum wage is adjusted by Decree 38/2022/ND–CP replacing Decree 90/2019/ND–CP. Here are four notable new points about regional minimum wages from 01 July 2022.

Paying 7% higher than the minimum wage for trained workers

Contents that have been implemented including the salary regime paid to employees who perform jobs or titles that require vocational training or vocational training at least **7% higher** than the minimum wage, shall continue to be implemented **unless otherwise agreed by the two parties in accordance with the Labor Law.**
